**The following Directives apply in any virtual court hearing before Mudau J as from 19 October 2020**

1. no person may film or electronically record judicial proceedings without the prior permission of the presiding Judge. The granting and the terms of any such permission is within the discretion of the presiding Judge.
2. Attention is further drawn to the provisions of paragraph 221 of the 18 September 2020 Consolidated Directive (*the Consolidated Directive*) dealing with media access to virtual court hearings and which expressly provides that such Directive does not replace the provisions set out in the High Court Practice Manual unless a deviation is specified and then only for the duration of the national state of disaster.
3. In order to ensure compliance with chapter 12.3 of the High Court Practice Manual during virtual hearings and to locate potential transgressors, any person to whom access is given to participate in a virtual hearing (or who is present at a virtual hearing) (*the linked participant*) is: (a) to provide a list of all who are present with them during the virtual hearing; and, (b) the linked participant is to undertake not to record or to permit any other person to record any part of the proceedings without prior thereto, obtaining the leave of the Judge in the manner prescribed in chapter 12.3 of the High Court Practice Manual.
4. Should any transgression occur in the presence of the linked participant, the linked participant is to disclose this to Judge Mudau forthwith.
5. Failure to comply with chapter 12.3 of the High Court Practice Manual may, as recorded in paragraph 3 thereof, lead to contempt of Court charges.
6. The list and undertaking contemplated in paragraph 3 hereof, is to be provided to Judge Mudau's registrar by no later than 15 minutes prior to the commencement of any virtual hearing presided over by her at [RSelepe@judiciary.org.za](mailto:RSelepe@judiciary.org.za) or [seleperose@.com](mailto:seleperose@.com). Failure to comply with this Directive may result in the matter being removed from the roll.
7. The link to the meeting will be posted on caselines on the case home page under hearing in the morning of the respective day.
8. Should the parties agree to remove or settle their matter before the day of the hearing you are directed to notify me as soon as possible.

9. Should any party seek to tender any document which is not already on caselines , leave should be sought prior to uploading.
