DIRECTIVES

1. This is directed to all attorneys and counsel with matters on the opposed motion roll before Barnardt AJ for 8 – 12 March 2021.
2. Whilst the allocations have been made as set out above, there may be changes and the parties will be informed of any of these when it arises.
3. The matters shall be heard via Microsoft Teams and the necessary link will be sent before the matter will be heard. Counsel and other legal representatives will receive the invitation and link for their matter from Pvilakazi@judiciary.org.za. Parties who do not receive an invitation by 9:00 on the day that their matter is to be heard, should contact Ms. Vilakazi telephonically.
4. Parties are to inform Ms. Vilakazi without delay if a matter has become settled, is to be postponed, or removed from the roll.
5. Parties must ensure that subparagraphs 2.1 to 2.16 of the Judge President's Directive 2 of 2020 dated 14 January 2020 are complied with.
6. Parties must ensure that paragraphs 102 to 109 of the Judge President's Consolidated Directive dated 18 September 2020 are complied with. If the joint practice note and the parties' heads of argument are not already uploaded to Caselines, it must be uploaded to Caselines and emailed to Pvilakazi@judiciary.org.za by no later than 14:00 on 5 March 2021.
7. Parties are to ensure that all of the requisite papers have been uploaded to Caselines, and that counsels' and other legal representatives' e-mail addresses and contact telephone numbers are included in their practice notes and joint practice notes.
8. Parties are requested to e-mail draft orders in Ms Word to Pvilakazi@judiciary.org.za by 9:00 on the day that a particular matter is heard.
9. Counsel must be robed when appearing on the virtual platform and must mute themselves when they are not arguing but they must be visible at all times when their matter is being heard.
