DIRECTIVES FOR URGENT COURT
FRIDAY 3 JULY 2020 FROM 16:00 to FRIDAY
10 JULY 2020

1. The matters will be dealt with by Tolmay J and Neukircher J, the particulars of their secretaries are as follows:

2. The phone number for the Urgent Court after hours is: 065 859 4819. Please note that this number should not be used during office hours.
3. There will be no roll call on Tuesday, 7 July 2020.
4. Strict regard will be had to the rules of urgency.
5. If cases are not ready at time of filing at 12:00 on Thursday 2 July 2020, they will not be heard, unless there is good cause or exceptional circumstances.

6. All urgent applications must include the certificate of urgency.
7. No piece-meal filing of affidavits will be allowed.
8. All cases must be uploaded on CaseLines. If any problems are experienced contact my secretary, Karin Erlank to assist.
9. A practice note must be filed setting out the following:
 - 9.1 the grounds for urgency;
 - 9.2 the nature of the application;
 - 9.3 the estimated duration of the matter;
 - 9.4 if there is non-compliance with the JP's directives issued for the lockdown period or the practice directives for urgent court, the reasons for such deviation;
 - 9.5 contact details for the legal practitioners, which must include both cellphone numbers and email addresses;
 - 9.6 if a hearing in open court is required, the reasons;
 - 9.7 if the matter is opposed: concise heads of argument should be filed by both parties before 12:00 on Monday 6 July 2020;
 - 9.8 whether the matter can be decided on the papers or whether a video conference is required.
10. If there is non-compliance with this practice directive the matter will be struck from the role, unless good cause is shown for non-compliance.
