- The following matters, the judge has difficulties:
 - a) No 38 – there is insufficient information provided regarding the time lapses between providing instructions, the writing of the letter of demand and specifically the lateness of this application. This is to be addressed in a supplementary affidavit and the matter may be removed for that purpose.
 - b) No 39 – I require a Notice of Withdrawal of Defence, an affidavit pre the Practice Directive and proof of service of the set down
 - c) No 43 – the incorrect procedure has be utilised
 - d) No 46 – the affidavit supporting the matter described the

applicant/plaintiff as "female". The oath states "he". A new affidavit is required.

- e) No 47 – the summons is illegible and must be re-loaded before this application can be considered
- f) No 48 – proper service is required
- g) No 49 – service is older than 6 months. Proof of service of the set down is needed
- h) No 50 – this is an opposed exception which must be set down on the opposed motion roll

- m) No 58 – service is stale. Proof of service of set down required.
- n) No 59 – no link
- o) No 61 – notice of motion dated 8/5/2020, founding affidavit dated 2/7/2020 – why? Insufficient information in par 5 for a court to exercise a discretion
- p) No 62 – no evidence regarding the best interests of the child has been set out in the affidavit so that the court can determine whether the relief sought should be granted. The parties are also still living together and insufficient information has been provided regarding the arrangements post divorce
- q) No 63 – the notice of motion is dated 8/5/2020, the founding affidavit is dated 1/7/2020 – why? Insufficient info in par 5.2 for a court to exercise its discretion.
- r) No 64 – the notice of motion states 3 August (instead of 13 August) Founding affidavit dated 15/11/2020 but adverts are 17/7/2020 – why? Information hopelessly outdated & insufficient info in par 5 for a court to exercise a discretion
- s) No 65 – where is the affidavit?
